FOLKS HONOR LAWMAKER'S REQUEST

Lake Elmo, Minnesota – 3 August 2010:

On 1 July 2010, the Stillwater Gazette published "Lawmaker asks folks to hold off on campaign signs" by Jennie Olsen. In the article, Rep. Bunn (D) of district 56A states, "There are very serious primaries taking place around the state right now, and people are still trying to determine who they're voting for ... Their putting up signs will be a part of their process of drawing attention to their races, when and if they do that. But the 56A House race is not involved in any primaries." The article continues, "state Rep. Julie Bunn says people should hold off until after the primary election to put (campaign signs) up." Along with being "visual pollution," it is further suggested that "voter confusion ... may be caused because of early inundation of political signs." Kathy Lohmer (R) has been heavily criticized for displaying signs before the primary.

One month later, Rep. Bunn quietly demonstrated her inability to keep her commitment in limiting voter confusion by ignoring her own request to hold off the posting of campaign signs before the primary. The only folks still honoring Bunn's request are supporters of her opponent, Jim Martin (independent Minnesota resident), who is not affiliated with any political party.
